

Although I like to read before going to bed, it isn't usually technical manuals I choose; and never before have I stayed up almost all night with such a book. This one I could not put down. I've been shooting professionally with the Nikon D7100 since I got it back in April and thought I understood all its functions. Aware of Darrell Young's expertise in teaching the technical aspects of Nikon cameras I ordered his Mastering the Nikon D7100 when first advertised. Because it wasn't in publication yet I

ordered two other books from two other authors detailing the different functions and setting on the camera. Neither one or both these other books cover the DETAIL Darrell Young covers. Darrell shows screen shots of every setting so there can be no mistake how to apply them. Later in the book he explains why you need to know these functions. There are so many AH HA moments in this book I'm going to have to read it several times. I found a number of details I didn't know the camera could do and the owner's manual did not tell me about. I've been shooting with Nikon cameras for about 40 years now, professionally and nonprofessionally, and have owned 11 different Nikon models. Hands-down, the D7100 is the best--but you probably know that if you own a D7100. But the D7100 is also quite complex. Just as PhotoShop is great software that you need a big book to get the most out of it, so do you need a book like this to get the most out of the D7100. I thought I knew Nikon DSLRs pretty well, but I was amazed when I thumbed through this book. I was literally learning something new on nearly every page--and at more than 500 pages, that's a lot of new information! This book is what every camera manual needs to be--full color throughout, color illustrations on nearly every page, detailed but clear explanations, writeups on every possible setting (with very helpful recommended settings and why). This book will walk you through all the different features/settings of the camera. It is not something you read casually but it is a lot better than reading the manual that came with the camera.
